How do I apply for the Concurrent Enrollment Program?

1. Answer every question on the application, sign, and date the form on the lines provided.
2. Pay a \$25.00 non-refundable one-time application fee.
3. Attach your most recent transcript from high school (obtained from your high school office).
4. Return all requested information and application fee to: College of Eastern Utah, 639 West 100 South, Blanding, UT 84511. If you have further questions, please contact the Admissions Office at (435) 678-2201, ext. 100.
5. All Concurrent Enrollment Students are enrolled as non-matriculated students and are not eligible for financial aid or scholarships. If a student wishes to continue enrollment after high school as a matriculated student, he or she must re-apply to College of Eastern Utah. The application fee will not be required again.
6. Concurrent enrollment students must complete this form each year he/she enrolls for classes.
