EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM



Early Childhood students are trained for future employment by working in the Daycare Lab that provides child-care services for students, staff, and community members. The Lab is open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. weekdays.

The Lab is equipped with new furniture, equipment, and the latest in books, games, and teaching aids.

Adjacent rooms include a fully equipped kitchen; a resource room filled with books, games, and educational toys; a mini computer lab; a diaper changing station; a quiet room for naps; and a spacious activity area.

Early Childhood interns create a warm, receptive atmosphere where children thrive and learn in the Preschool Teaching Lab. The interns observe, practice, and master early childhood development skills they will take with them into the professional child-care or home-care setting.
