

General Education and Prerequisite Courses

The Weber State University Outreach Radiologic Technology Program is offered at the College of Eastern Utah-San Juan Campus through a cooperative agreement between the two schools. Students, who are high school graduates, can take the required general education and prerequisite radiologic technology courses at CEU-SJC during their first year. Upon acceptance into the program, radiologic technology students can complete the next two years of course work at CEU-SJC with limited travel to WSU for specialized labs. CEU-SJC will use local hospitals and clinics as clinical sites for the hands-on part of the program.



Before students are accepted into the program, they must complete the general education and prerequisite classes listed below:

Enrollment into this two-year associate of applied science degree program is competitive and limited to 15 to 20 students. Application deadline is January 10 and all general education and prerequisite classes must be completed before that date, along with submission of official transcripts, application form, and three personal references. Applicants are required to complete an FBI background check and drug screening at their own expense. Individuals convicted of, plead guilty to, or nolo contendere to a felony, gross misdemeanor or misdemeanor, alcohol and/or drug-related violations, should contact the department before applying to the program. Applicants will be notified of acceptance or non-acceptance by May of each year.

The two-year cost of textbooks and module expenses for the radiologic technology program is approximately \$900. This does not include the cost of tuition, supplies, uniforms/lab coats and travel expenses.
